## TECHNICAL NOTES

**Brand:** Dante Robino

**Varietal:** 100% Malbec

**Alcohol:** 13.8% by vol.

**Ageing:** French/American Oak 3 mo.

## WINEMAKING

Implanted in stony good-drainage soil in an area with a wide temperature range between day and night. The land is 900m above sea level. The vineyard yield is 7 tons/ha. After ageing the wine is stabilized and bottled. Then the winemaker allows the wine to settle in the underground wine cellar for 6 months.

## TASTING NOTES

Red, with purple hues, intense and complete. You'll find red fruit such as blackberry and plum, with subtle barrel notes. On the palate, it has soft tannins with a good balance of fruit and oak. A subtle Malbec with a long finish, ideal for those who enjoy balanced elegant wines.

## SUGGESTED FOOD PAIRINGS

Enjoy this wine with typical Argentinian grilled meat, stuffed pasta, lasagna, spicy empanadas, ripened cheese or rice with vegetables and mushrooms.
