## TECHNICAL NOTES

**Sub-region:** Lujan de Cuyo

**Alcohol:** 15% by vol.

**Varietal:** 100% Malbec

**Ageing:** American Oak 12 mo.

## WINEMAKING

The fruit is harvested from well-kept vineyards, with high enological quality and low production. There is a phenolic ripening and sugar level monitoring of the vines up to the moment of grinding. Harvest is manual and grapes are stalked, refrigerated and fermented during grinding. From there, they are sent to vessels equipped with temperature panels that allow for refrigerant and hot water passage.

## TASTING NOTES

**Color:** Lively violet red color with crimson highlights. Full bodied wine.

**Aromas:** Red fruity aromas with scents of vanilla and chocolate.

**Flavors:** Elegant entry. Smooth texture with round tannins. Fruity palate, full of berries, plums, vanilla and chocolate. Long finish.

Enjoy this wine with grilled meat, hard grain and blue cheeses, traditional pasta with heavy sauces.
