TECHNICAL NOTES

Sub-region: Maipu

Origin: Pedriel / Agrelo, Lujan de Cuyo, Mendoza, Argentina

Alcohol: 13.5% by vol.

Varietal: 100% Malbec

WINEMAKING

Grapes are harvested from selected vineyards. Harvest is manual, grapes are de-stemmed, refrigerated and then fermented at 25°C. Alcoholic fermentation takes place for about 10 days. When it finishes, short macerations take place to get fruity medium-structured wines.

TASTING NOTES

A young, fruity Malbec of attractive red color, vivacious and with ruby glints. Red and black fruit, such as plum and blackberry, and species in the complex background make this varietal alive, and velvety with tons of fruit on the palate.

SUGGESTED FOOD PAIRINGS

Enjoy this wine with foods such as red grilled meat, tomato sauce pasta, stuffed pasta, empanadas, meat pie, and hard cheeses.
